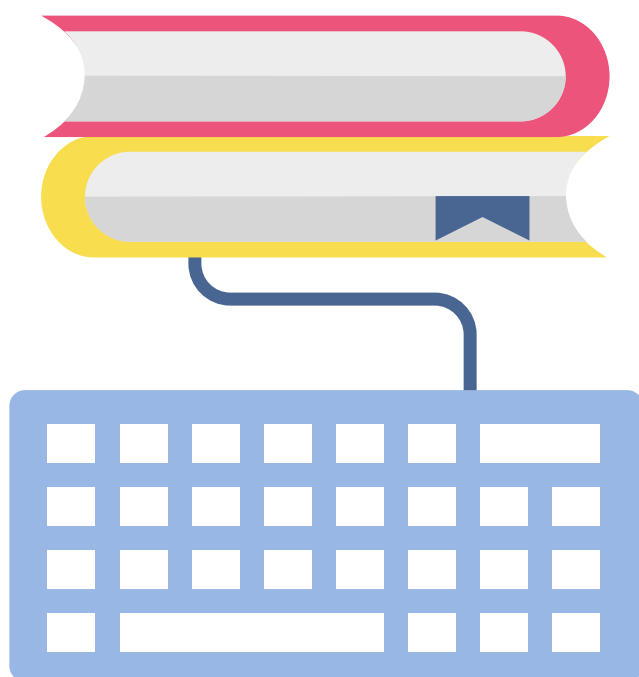
Explore novel pedagogical scenarios in an interactive virtual museum environment.
